At a meeting of the County Commissioners, held at Dedham, within and for said County of Norfolk., on the fifteenth day of May A.D. 2024, by adjournment of their April meeting next preceding, a notice of said meeting having been duly posted as required by law:

UPON THE PETITION OF the Inhabitants of the Town of Stoughton and the Town of Stoughton acting through its Select Board, in said County, representing that common convenience and necessity require that a portion of the **Norfolk County Layout of Page Street dated October 22, 1872, a public way in Stoughton, MA, be discontinued**, the area being shown as "Area of Discontinuance" containing 33,642 square feet on a plan entitled "Plan showing the discontinuance of a portion of the October 22, 1872 Norfolk County Layout of PAGE STREET in Stoughton, MA, between the Old Page Street and the Page Street (1956 Relocation)", and on a plan entitled "Plan showing the reservation of access/egress and utility easements and apportionment of a discontinued portion of the October 22, 1872 Norfolk County Layout of PAGE STREET in Stoughton, MA between the Old Page Street and the Page Street (1956 Relocation)", both plans scale 1 inch = 60 feet, and on a plan entitled "Plan showing the layout of a subdivision road in Stoughton, MA across land now or formerly of T.L. Edwards, Inc.", plan scale 1 inch = 50 feet, all plans dated September 13, 2023, prepared by Langan Engineering & Environmental Services, Inc and sealed by Ian C. Wisuri, PLS, all in said Stoughton. **WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONERS PRAY** that a portion of said way may be discontinued within the limits as specified above.

On the Petition aforesaid, Ordered, that the County Commissioners meet at the County of Norfolk Administrative Offices, second floor, 614 High Street Dedham, MA 02026 on Wednesday June 12th, 2024, at 1:30 o'clock P.M. to hear and act on said petition and view the route described in said petition if deemed necessary.

Executive Order on Remote Participation: On Wednesday, March 29, 2023, Governor Healey signed into law Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2023, "An act making appropriations for Fiscal Year 2023 [...] which includes a two-year extension of the option for public bodies to hold remote meetings, by suspending certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law, General Law Chapter 30A, Section 20. That action was effective immediately extending the current option for remote meetings through March 31, 2025., this PUBLIC HEARING will be conducted via in-person and via remote participation).
