At a meeting of the County Commissioners, held at Dedham, within and for said County of Norfolk., on the fifteenth day of November A.D. 2023, by adjournment of their September meeting next preceding, a notice of said meeting having been duly posted as required by law:

UPON THE PETITION OF the Town of Stoughton acting through its Select Board, inhabitants of the Town of Stoughton in said County, representing that common convenience and necessity require that a portion of the **Norfolk County Layout of Page Street dated October 22, 1872, a public way in Stoughton, MA, be altered between the Avon-Stoughton Town Line and the Easterly sideline of the December 4, 1956 & May 23, 1955 AMVETS State Highway Layout of Route 24, being State highway Layout numbers 4510 & 4348**, said alterations being shown on a plan entitled: "Plan showing the discontinuance of a portion of the October 22, 1872 Norfolk County Layout of PAGE STREET in Stoughton, MA between the Avon – Stoughton Town Line and the easterly sideline of the December 4, 1956 State Highway Layout of the AMVETS Memorial Highway (SHLO #4510) and the easterly sideline of the May 23, 1955 State Highway Layout of the AMVETS Memorial Highway (SHLO #4348)", scale 1 inch = 30 feet, dated February 2, 2022, prepared by Curley & Hansen Surveyors and sealed by William P. Self, PLS. WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONERS PRAY that said alterations may be made within the limits above specified.

On the Petition aforesaid, Ordered, that the County Commissioners meet at the County of Norfolk Administrative Offices, second floor, 614 High Street Dedham, MA 02026 on December 20th, 2023, at 1:30 o'clock P.M. to hear and act on said petition and view the route described in said petition if deemed necessary.

Executive Order on Remote Participation: On Wednesday, March 29, 2023, Governor Healey signed into law Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2023, "An act making appropriations for Fiscal Year 2023 [...] which includes a two-year extension of the option for public bodies to hold remote meetings, by suspending certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law, General Law Chapter 30A, Section 20. That action was effective immediately extending the current option for remote meetings through March 31, 2025., this PUBLIC HEARING will be conducted via in-person and via remote participation.
