COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Norfolk ss. At a meeting of the County Commissioners for the County of Norfolk held at Dedham within and for said County on the nineteenth day of May 1925 by adjournment of their April Meeting next preceding; The petition of Roger Dennett and others of Sharon in said County represents as follows; Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Norfolk ss. To the Honorable the County Commissioners of the County of Norfolk; Respectfully represent your petitioners, inhabitants of the town of Sharon in said County, that common convenience and necessity require that the way known as Norwood Street a public way in said town be relocated between Upland Road and Bullard Street for the purpose of establishing the boundary lines making alterations in the course or width of said way and for the purpose of reconstruction. WHEREFORE your petitioners pray that said way may be so relocated within the limits above specified, dated January 21, 1925.

This petition was presented to the commissioners and duly entered at a meeting of said commissioners held at Dedham aforesaid on the twenty-seventh day of January 1925 by adjournment of their December Meeting next preceding and the tenth day of March then next and 3.30 o'clock in the afternoon at the selectmen's room in said Sharon were appointed by the Commissioners as the time and place for commencing and proceeding to view the premises and they thereupon caused a copy of said petition and of this order thereon to be served upon the clerk of the Town of Sharon being the town within which such relocation of way was prayed for thirty days at least before the time appointed for said view and also caused copies of said petition and order to be posted in two public places in said town and also gave notice to all persons interested by causing a like copy to be published three weeks successively in the Sharon Advocate a newspaper published in said county, said posting and the last publication of said copy having been fourteen days at least before the time appointed for said view that all persons

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and corporations interested for or against said petition might then and there appear and be heard if they saw fit. And on the said tenth day of March the commissioners, Evan F. Richardson, Edward W. Hunt and Frederick A. Leavitt met at the time and place specified in said order, when and where the petitioners appeared and the Town of Sharon was represented by its selectmen and the said commissioners then viewed the route and premises and heard all persons and corporations interested and no party interested objected and said hearing was then continued and adjourned to a meeting of the commissioners held at Sharon aforesaid on the thirty-first day of March 1925 by adjournment of their December Meeting next preceding when and where the said commissioners proceeded to consider and adjudicate upon the prayer of said petition and thereupon the said commissioners did adjudge that common convenience and necessity require said way be relocated as prayed for in said petition. And thence the same was continued and adjourned from time to time to this meeting. And now the said commissioners by courses and distances, metes and bounds do relocate said Norwood Street in SHARON as prayed for in said petition. And the lines of said relocation of said Norwood Street are as follows; The westerly line begins at a stone bound in the present westerly line of Norwood Street, said bound being about 1040 feet southerly from Maskwonicut Street; thence northerly and westerly by a 350 foot radius curve 228.41 feet to a stone bound; thence continuing by the same curve 228.41 feet to a stone bound; thence N.61-14-15 W in the present westerly line of said Norwood Street 145.39 feet to a stone bound; thence continuing in said westerly line of Norwood Street by a 497.68 foot radius curve to the right 366.86 feet to a stone bound; thence N.19-00-10 W 196.2 feet to a stone bound; thence by a 2000 foot radius curve to the left 314.62 feet to a stone bound; thence continuing by the same curve 314.62 feet to a stone bound; thence N.37-01-45 W 222.81 feet to a stone bound in the present westerly line of said Norwood Street in land of John F. Coleman. The easterly line begins at a stone bound in the present easterly line of said Norwood Street, said bound bearing N.54-59-35 E. and distant 75.54 feet from the point of beginning of the westerly line as above described; thence in the present easterly line of said Norwood Street northerly and westerly by a 325.92 foot radius curve, 425.39 feet to a stone bound; thence continuing in said easterly line N.61-14-15 W 65.94 feet to a stone bound; thence by a 800 foot radius curve to the right 228.3 feet to a stone bound; thence continuing by the same curve 228.3 feet to a stone bound; thence by a 25.75 foot radius curve to the right 49.02 feet to a stone bound; thence N.9-27-10 W about five feet to the southerly line of Maskwonicut Street; thence the same course about 28 feet to a stone bound in the northerly line of Maskwoni-

cut Street;thence westerly and northerly by a 55.38 foot radius curve 77.76 feet to a stone bound;thence N.19-00-10 W.75.93 feet to a stone bound;thence by a 2050 foot radius curve to the left 322.485 feet to a stone bound;thence continuing by the same curve 322.485 feet to a stone bound;thence N.37-01-45 W.222.81 feet to a stone bound in the present easterly line of said Norwood Street said bound bearing N.52-58-15 E.and distant 50 feet from the last bound in the westerly line as above described. Said lines are shown in red upon a plan entitled "Plan showing the Relocation and Widening of a Portion of Norwood Street in the Town of Sharon as made by the Norfolk County Commissioners,Evan F.Richardson,Chairman,Surveyed May 1925,Scale 1 inch - 40 feet,Hartley L.White,County Engineer" which plan is filed herewith and made a part of this return. And the said commissioners do hereby take for the purposes of a highway all the lands included within the lines of relocation hereinbefore described and as shown on the plan hereinbefore referred to and made a part hereof in so far as such lands may lie outside the limits of said way as heretofore defined. And permanent stone or concrete bounds,not less than three feet long two feet of which at least shall be inserted in the earth will be erected at the termini and angles of the way relocated as aforesaid when practicable and when not so,a heap of stones,a living tree,a permanent rock or the corner of an edifice will be a substitute or said bounds may be permanent stone or concrete bounds not less than three feet long with holes drilled therein and filled with lead placed a few inches below the travelled part of the street or way. And it is determined by the commissioners that the inhabitants of the Town of Sharon do within one year from the date of this return and order complete said way in a thorough and workmanlike manner and to the acceptance of the County Commissioners. Said way shall be constructed to the full width indicated on said plan,throughout the entire length of the portion relocated by this return and order. Suitable sidewalks,gutters,culverts,retaining walls,fences and railings shall be constructed wherever needed. And it is determined by the commissioners that all the expenses of making the relocation of way prescribed in this return and order including the expenses of constructing said way and all land and other damages and expenses incident thereto be paid by the Inhabitants of the Town of Sharon and that the county of Norfolk shall pay to the Inhabitants of the Town of Sharon the sum of seven hundred and thirty-five dollars(\$735)payment thereof to be made at such time as the commissioners may determine having regard to the amount of the work done and the proportion of the expense to be paid by the county. And the commissioners have heard the proprietors of lands and property,rights and interests taken or affected by these proceedings

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and have considered and estimated the damages sustained in the premises having had regard to all the damages done to the parties respectively whether by taking their property or injuring it in any manner and having allowed by way of set off the benefits if any to the property of said parties in the premises and do estimate and determine the damages to be paid to said parties respectively in the sums hereafter named, the same to be paid to said parties respectively by the Inhabitants of the Town of Sharon when the lands hereby taken and over which said relocation of said way is hereby located have been entered upon and possession taken for the purpose of constructing the said way.
