To the Honorable the County Commissioners of the County of Norfolk: Respectfully represent your petitioners, inhabitants of the town of Canton in said County, that common convenience and necessity require that the way known as Randolph Street, a public way in said town be relocated at or near the Randolph Town Line for the purpose of discontinuing the whole or any part of the said way lying along the Randolph-Canton town line and known as either Canton Street or Randolph Street in said Canton. And the lines of said relocation of said Randolph Street are as follows: Beginning at a stone bound in the southerly line of said Randolph Street, said bound bearing S-69-35-30-W 90.48 ft. from the road stone in the Canton-Randolph town line on the northerly side of said street and being at the point of compound curvature of a 756.15 ft. radius curve and a 251.49 ft. radius curve in the layout of Randolph Street, Canton as made by the Norfolk County Commissioners by Return dated May 28, 1929; thence southeasterly and southerly by a 756.15 ft. radius curve 152.23 ft. to a stone bound in the Canton-Randolph town line, said bound bearing S-22-19-00-E 119.12 ft. from the above mentioned road stone; meaning and intending to discontinue that portion of the 1929 layout lying south of the above described line.
