COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

At a meeting of the County Commissioners for the County of Norfolk, held at Dedham, within and for said County, on the twenty-second day of May 1973, by adjournment of their April meeting next preceding; a notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law:

The petition of THOMAS P McCUSKER, JR. and others of WESTWOOD in said County represents as follows:

Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Norfolk, ss.

To the Honorable the County Commissioners of the County of Norfolk:

Respectfully represent your petitioners, Inhabitants of the Town of Westwood in said County, that common convenience and necessity require that the way known as GREEN LODGE STREET, a public way in said town, be discontinued between the Dedham Town Line and the State Highway layout of January 10, 1955, being the remaining portion of the Norfolk County Commissioners' layout of January 26, 1932; the purposes for which said street was laid out no longer exist.

Wherefore your petitioners pray that said way may be discontinued within the limits above specified.

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This petition was presented to the Commissioners and duly entered at a meeting of said Commissioners, held at Dedham, on the third day of April, 1973 by adjournment of their December meeting next preceding; a notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law; and the eighth day of May, 1973 and two forty-five o'clock in the afternoon at the Court House in said Dedham were appointed by said Commissioners as the time and place for commencing and proceeding to view the premises; and they thereupon caused a copy of said petition and of order of notice thereon to be

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served upon the Clerk of the Town of Westwood, being the town within which such discontinuance was prayed for, fifteen days at least before the time appointed for said view, and also caused copies of an abstract of said petition and of said order of notice to be posted in two public places in said town; and to be published in the WESTWOOD PRESS, a newspaper published in said County, said posting and publication having been seven days at least before the time appointed for said view, that all persons and corporations interested, for or against said petition, might then and there appear and be heard if they saw fit.

And on the said eighth day of May, 1973 the Commissioners, James J. Collins, Thomas K. McManus, and George B. McDonald, met at the time and place specified in said Order, when and where the petitioners appeared and the Town of WESTWOOD was represented by its Selectmen; and the said Commissioners then viewed the route and premises, and heard all persons and corporations interested; and thereupon, the said Commissioners did adjudge that common convenience and necessity require that said way be discontinued as prayed for in said petition.

And thence the same was continued and adjourned from time to time to this meeting.

And now the said Commissioners do hereby discontinue two portions of Green Lodge Street between the Dedham Town Line and Blue Hill Drive.

And the lines and portions of said discontinuance of said GREEN LODGE STREET are as follows:

Parcel 1. Beginning at the northeasterly end of Parcel 1 at a point on the line between the Towns of Dedham and Westwood; thence southerly by the easterly line of Green Lodge Street as laid out by the Norfolk County Commissioners by return dated January 26, 1932, 110<sup>+</sup> feet; thence southwesterly and westerly by the northeasterly line of Yankee Division Highway in the Town of Westwood, as laid out by the Massachusetts Department of Public

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Works January 10, 1955, 20<sup>±</sup> feet and 43<sup>±</sup> feet respectively; thence by the westerly line of said 1932 layout of Green Lodge Street, 222<sup>±</sup> feet; thence by the said Dedham-Westwood Town Line, 21.00 ft. and 91.46 ft. respectively to the point of beginning.

Parcel 2. Beginning at the northerly end of Parcel 2 at a point on said northeasterly line of Yankee Division Highway as above described; thence southeasterly by the easterly line of Green Lodge Street as above described, 137<sup>±</sup> feet; thence northwesterly and northerly by the line of Blue Hill Drive as laid out by the Massachusetts Department of Public Works January 10, 1955 and Yankee Division Highway as above described, 70.66 feet and 68<sup>±</sup> feet respectively to the point of beginning.

And it is determined by the Commissioners that all lands within the lines of Parcels 1 and 2 above described are hereby discontinued as a Highway.

Said lines and parcels are shown upon a plan entitled "Plan Showing the Discontinuance of Green Lodge Street, Westwood, between The Dedham Town Line and Blue Hill Drive, as made by the Norfolk County Commissioners by Return dated May 22, 1973. Scale: 1 inch = 40 feet, Alvah L. Downs, County Engineer" and signed by "James J. Collins, Chairman" which plan is filed herewith and made a part of this Return.
