RESPECTFULLY REPRESENT YOUR PETITIONERS, inhabitants of the town of Wellesley in said County, that common convenience and necessity require that a portion of Washington Street in said Wellesley, be discontinued as a highway at Wiswall Circle, which portion lies northerly of a line sixty feet northerly of and parallel to the Southerly line of said Washington Street.

WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONERS PRAY that said discontinuance may be made within the limits above specified.

This petition was presented to the Commissioners and duly entered at a meeting of said Commissioners, held at Dedham, on the twenty-eighth day of October, 1981, by adjournment of their September meeting, next preceding, a notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law: and the second day of December,

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1981 and two-thirty o'clock in the afternoon at the Court House in said Dedham were appointed by the Commissioners as the time and place for commencing and proceeding to view the premises; and they thereupon caused a copy of said petition, and of order of notice thereon, to be served upon the Clerk of the Town of WELLESLEY, being the town within which such discontinuance was prayed for, fifteen days at least before the time appointed for said view: and also caused copies of an abstract of said petition and of said order of notice to be posted in two public places in said town: and to be published in the Wellesley Townsman, a newspaper published in Wellesley, Mass., said posting and publication having been seven days at least before the time appointed for said view, that all persons and corporations interested for or against said petition, might then and there appear and be heard if they saw fit.

And on the said second day of December, 1981, the Commissioners, James J. Collins and David C. Ahearn, met at the time and place specified in said order, when and where the petitioners appeared and the Town of WELLESLEY was represented by its Selectmen; and the said Commissioners then viewed the route and premises, and heard all persons and corporations interested; and no party interested objected: and thereupon the said Commissioners did adjudge that common convenience and necessity require that said way be discontinued as prayed for in said petition, provided that a signed release of all claims or demands is received from the owner of the adjacent property prior to the adoption of a Return and Order.

And thence the same was continued and adjourned from time to time to this meeting.

And now the Commissioners, James J. Collins, George B. McDonald and David C. Ahearn, by courses and distances, metes and bounds, do hereby discontinue a portion of said Washington Street at Wiswall Circle, as prayed for in said petition.

And the lines of said discontinuance of said Washington Street are as follows:

Beginning at a stone bound on the northerly line of Washington Street as laid out by the Norfolk County Commissioners by return dated April 30, 1963, said bound being opposite station 86+01.30; thence by said northerly line of said 1963 layout; northerly and westerly by a 20.00 ft. radius curve, 32.74 ft. to a stone bound, N-21°-01'-35"-E, 30.02 ft. to a stone bound and easterly and northerly by a 20.00 ft. radius curve, 32.16 ft. to a stone bound which is opposite station 86+76.49; thence southerly and southwesterly by a 700.00 ft. radius curve, 72.10 ft. to the point of beginning. Being shown as "Parcel 1 - 815 S.F." on the plan hereinafter referred to.

And it is determined by the Commissioners that all lands within the lines above described are hereby discontinued as a highway.

All of said lines are shown upon a plan entitled "Plan showing the Discontinuance of a portion of Washington Street, Wellesley at Wiswall Circle, as made by the Norfolk County Commissioners by Return dated December 30, 1981. Scale: 1 inch = 20 feet. Alvah L. Downs, County Engineer, and signed by James J. Collins, Chairman" which plan is filed herewith and made a part of this return.
