This petition was presented to the Commissioners and duly entered at a meeting of said Commissioners, held at Dedham, aforesaid on the eighth day of April, 1952, by adjournment of their December meeting next preceding: and the thirteenth day of May, 1952, and two-thirty o'clock in the afternoon at the Court House in Dedham were appointed by the said Commissioners as the time and place for commencing and proceeding to view the premises; and they thereupon caused a copy of said petition, and of order of notice thereon, to be served upon the Clerk of the Town of FOXBOROUGH being the town within which such relocation of way war prayed for, fifteen days at least before the time appointed for said view: and also caused copies of an abstract of said petition and of said order of notice to be posted in two public places in said town: and to be published in the FOXBORO REPORTER, a newspaper published in said County, said posting and publication having been seven days at least before the time appointed for said view, that all persons and corporations interested for or against said petition might then and there appear and be heard if they saw fit.

Suitable sidewalks, gutters, culverts, retaining walls, fences and railings shall be constructed, wherever, in the opinion of the County Commissioners, they are needed, provided however, no trees more than one and one half inches in diameter one foot above the ground shall be removed in the course of work done under this paragraph until the County Commissioners have been given notice of the intention to remove such trees and their assent thereto in writing has been given to the Inhabitants of the Town of FOXBOROUGH.

And it is determined by the Commissioners that all the expense of making the relocation of way prescribed in this Return and Order including the expenses of constructing said way, and all land and other damages and expenses incident thereto, be paid by the Inhabitants of the Town of FOXBOROUGH.

And the Commissioners have heard the proprietors of lands and property, rights and interests, taken or affected by these proceedings, and have considered and estimated the damages sustained in the premises, having had regard to all the damages done to the parties respectively, whether by taking their property or injuring it in any manner, and having allowed by

way of set off, the benefits, if any, to the property of said parties in the premises, and do estimate and determine the damages to be paid to said parties respectively, in the sums hereafter named; the same to be paid to said parties respectively by the Inhabitants of the Town of FOXBOROUGH when the lands hereby taken and over which said way is hereby located, have been entered upon and possession taken, for the purpose of constructing the said way.
