Respectfully represent your petitioners, inhabitants of the Town of WEYMOUTH in said County, that common convenience and necessity require that the way known as COMMERCIAL STREET, a public way in said town, be relocated between North and Broad Streets for the purpose of establishing the boundary lines of said way; making alterations in the course or width of said way; and making repairs on said way.

Wherefore your petitioners pray that said way may be re-located within the limits above specified.

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This petition was presented to the Commissioners and duly entered at a meeting of said Commissioners, held at Dedham, on the twenty-first day of July, 1959, by adjournment of their June meeting next preceding, a notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law; and the eleventh day of August, 1959, and two-thirty o'clock in the afternoon at the Court House in said Dedham were appointed by said Commissioners as the time and place for commencing and proceeding to view the premises; and they thereupon caused a copy of said petition and of order of

notice thereon, to be served upon the Clerk of the Town of WEYMOUTH being the town within which such relocation of way was prayed for, fifteen days at least before the time appointed for said view; and also caused copies of an abstract of said petition and of said order of notice to be posted in two public places in said town; and to be published in the WEYMOUTH GAZETTE, a newspaper published in said County, said posting and publication having been seven days at least before the time appointed for said view, that all persons and corporations interested for or against said petition, might then and there appear and be heard if they saw fit.

And on the said eleventh day of August, 1959, the Commissioners Russell T. Bates, Everett M. Bowker and Ainslie K. Payne (acting in place of Clayton W. Nash who was disqualified by reason of residence) met at the time and place specified in said order; when and where the petitioners appeared and the Town of WEYMOUTH was represented by its Selectmen; and the said Commissioners then viewed the route and premises, and heard all persons and corporations interested; and no party interested objected; and thereupon the said Commissioners did adjudge that common convenience and necessity require that said way be relocated as prayed for in said petition.

And thence the same was continued and adjourned from time to time to a meeting of the Commissioners held at Dedham on the fourth day of April, 1961, by adjournment of the December meeting next preceding, a notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law; when and where upon the adjudication aforesaid, the Commissioners appointed the second day of May, 1961, and three-thirty o'clock in the afternoon at the Town Hall in WEYMOUTH as the time and place when they would proceed to and take such action in relation to said adjudication as by law they might be authorized to do.

And having given notice of such adjudication and of the time and place appointed, and for the purpose aforesaid

in the same manner as the notice and publication were given and made before first proceeding to view, the said Commissioners met at the time and place appointed and then and there heard all persons and corporations interested, and said hearing was continued and adjourned from time to time to this meeting.

And now the said Commissioners, by courses and distances, metes and bounds, do relocate said COMMERCIAL STREET, as prayed for in said petition.

And the lines of said relocation of said COMMERCIAL STREET, are as follows:-

The easterly line begins at a stone bound on the easterly line of North Street; thence S-35-27-07-E a distance of 87.12 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the right with a radius of 3438.83 ft. a distance of 119.99 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-33-27-10-E a distance of 271.83 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-31-54-20-E a distance of 442.00 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 600.00 ft. a distance of 17.28 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 29.34 ft. a distance of 44.10 ft. to a stone bound which is on the northwesterly line of James Road; thence S-45-55-00-E a distance of 42.01 ft. to a stone bound which is on the southeasterly line of James Road; thence southwesterly by a curve with a radius of 25.23 ft. a distance of 47.01 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 600.00 ft. a distance of 49.72 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-47-51-00-E a distance of 134.59 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 350.00 ft. a distance of 217.12 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 25.00 ft. a distance of 46.75 ft. to a stone bound which is on the westerly line of Genevieve Road; thence S-83-13-58-E a distance of 41.90 ft. to a stone bound which is on the easterly line of Genevieve Road; thence southeasterly by a curve with a radius of 30.00 ft. a distance of

42.95 ft. to a stone bound; thence N-87-26-30-E a distance of 345.14 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-58-44-50-E a distance of 96.75 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 15.00 ft. a distance of 21.71 ft. to a stone bound which is on the northwesterly line of Mt. with a radius of 199.60 ft. a distance of 81.61 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-28-24-40-E a distance of 425.69 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 1000.00 ft. a distance of 227.57 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-41-27-E a distance of 370.64 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 600.00 ft. a distance of 53.55 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 30.00 ft. a distance of 42.62 ft. to a stone bound which is on the northwesterly line of Drew Avenue; thence S-62-28-10-E a distance of 38.47 ft. to a stone bound which is on the southeasterly line of Drew Avenue; thence southeasterly by a curve with a radius of 25.00 ft. a distance of 47.02 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 600.00 ft. a distance of 121.65 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-67-19-30-E a distance of 276.25 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 60.00 ft. a distance of 71.44 ft. to a stone bound which is on the northwesterly line of East Street; thence S-12-11-50-E a distance of 48.46 ft. to a stone bound which is on the southeasterly line of East Street.

The westerly line begins at a stone bound on the westerly line of North Street and the northerly line of Commercial Street as laid out by the Norfolk County Commissioners by Return dated August 19, 1958; said bound being N-84-48-W a distance of 92.24 ft. from the first bound on the easterly line as above described; thence southwesterly by a curve with a radius of 101.21 ft. a distance of 141.67 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-64-14-20-E a distance of 70.82 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the right with a radius of 84.44 ft. a distance of 130.72 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-33-27-10-E a distance of 127.21 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the right with a radius of 15.00 ft. a distance of 24.19 ft. to a stone bound which is on the northwesterly line of Richards Road; thence S-35-15-E a distance of 40.11 ft. to a stone bound which

thence S-55-43-40-E a distance of 218.80 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the right with a radius of 25.00 ft. a distance of 39.25 ft. to a stone bound which is on the northwesterly line of Fiske Avenue; thence S-55-01-10-E a distance of 40.00 ft. to a stone bound which is on the southeasterly line of Fiske Avenue; thence northeasterly by a curve with a radius of 25.00 ft. a distance of 39.90 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the right with a radius of 1600.00 ft. a distance of 166.99 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-48-21-20-E a distance of 284.91 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the right with a radius of 1000.00 ft. a distance of 348.10 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-28-24-40-E a distance of 204.51 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 1060.00 ft. a distance of 241.23 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-41-27-E a distance of 84.75 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the right with a radius of 30.00 ft. a distance of 48.23 ft. to a stone bound which is on the northwesterly line of Putnam Avenue; thence S-44-37-E a distance of 40.17 ft. to a stone bound which is on the southeasterly line of Putnam Avenue; thence northeasterly by a curve with a radius of 30.00 ft. a distance of 46.01 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-41-27-E a distance of 185.83 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the left with a radius of 660.00 ft. a distance of 298.06 ft. to a stone bound; thence S-67-19-30-E a distance of 95.25 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the right with a radius of 400.00 ft. a distance of 205.74 ft. to a stone bound; thence by a curve to the right with a radius of 35.00 ft. a distance of 49.76 ft. to a stone bound which is on the northerly line of Madison Street, said bound being S-41-03-40-W a distance of 131.26 ft. and S-43-36-10-W a distance of 30.14 ft. from the last bound on the easterly line as above described.

The westerly line heretofore described, in general, is 60.00 ft. westerly from and parallel to the easterly line.

And the said Commissioners do hereby take for the purposes of a highway all the fee and rights incident to a public highway in the lands included within the lines of location hereinbefore described, except those portions of land belonging to the Town of Weymouth, (shown as parcels <sup>#54</sup>/#57, #58, #59, #72 and #71,) over which side lines are established, and the grade thereof is established all as shown upon a plan entitled "Plan and Profile showing the Relocation and Widening of a portion of Commercial Street, Weymouth from North Street to Madison Street as made by the Norfolk County Commissioners, by Return dated August 22, 1961. Horizontal Scale: 1 inch = 40 feet. Vertical Scale: 1 inch = 8 feet. Wallace S. Carson, County Engineer" and signed by "Russell T. Bates, Chairman" which plan is filed herewith and made a part of this Return in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 79 of the General Laws, and all acts and amendments thereof and in addition thereto.

And the said Commissioners do likewise further take all the easements in lands adjoining the location of said way as hereby established, consisting of the right to have the lands of said location protected by having the surface of the adjoining land slope from the lines of said locations as indicated on said plan,

And permanent stone bounds will be erected at the termini and angles of said way relocated as aforesaid.

And it is determined by the Commissioners that all portions of the existing highway lying outside the lines herein established are hereby discontinued.

And it is determined by the Commissioners, that the Inhabitants of the Town of WEYMOUTH, do within five years from the date of this Return and Order complete said way in a thorough and workmanlike manner and to the acceptance of the County Commissioners

The travelled part of said way shall be constructed not less than thirty (30) feet in width.



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Suitable sidewalks, gutters, culverts, retaining walls, fences and railings shall be constructed, wherever, in the opinion of the County Commissioners, they are needed, provided, however, no trees more than one and one half inches in diameter one foot above the ground shall be removed in the course of work done under this paragraph until the County Commissioners have been given notice of the intention to remove such trees and their assent thereto in writing has been given to the Inhabitants of the Town of WEYMOUTH.

And it is determined by the Commissioners that all the expense of making the relocation of way prescribed in this Return and Order including the expense of constructing said way, and all land and other damages and expenses incident thereto, be paid by the Inhabitants of the Town of WEYMOUTH.

And the Commissioners have heard the proprietors of lands and property, rights and interests, taken or affected by these proceedings, and have considered and estimated the damages sustained in the premises, having had regard to all the damages done to the parties respectively, whether by taking their property or injuring it in any manner, and having allowed by way of set off, the benefits, if any, to the property of said parties in the premises, and do estimate and determine the damages to be paid to said parties respectively, in the sums hereafter named; the same to be paid to said parties respectively by the Inhabitants of the Town of WEYMOUTH when the lands hereby taken and over which said way is hereby located, have been entered upon and possession taken, for the purpose of constructing said way.
