At a meeting of the County Commissioners for the County of Norfolk, held at Dedham, within and for said County on the thirteenth day of November, 1962, by adjournment of their September meeting next preceding: a notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law:-

The petition of LEONARD P. GRAHAM and others of CANTON in said County represents as follows:-

Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Norfolk, ss.

To the Honorable the County Commissioners of the County of Norfolk:

Respectfully represent your petitioners, inhabitants of the Town of CANTON in said County, that common convenience and necessity require that the ways known as Green and Greenlodge Streets, public ways in said town, be discontinued as a highway between the State Highway Route #128 and a line 60 feet northerly and parallel to the southerly line of Greenlodge Street.

Wherefore your petitioners pray that said ways may be discontinued within the limits above specified. An easement 15' wide centered on existing water main to be retained by the Town of Canton within discontinued limits.

This petition was presented to the Commissioners and duly entered at a meeting of said Commissioners, held at Dedham, on the eighteenth day of September, 1962, by adjournment of their June meeting, next preceding, a notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law: and the ninth day of October, 1962 and three o'clock in the afternoon at the Court House in said Dedham were appointed by the Commissioners as the time and place for commencing and proceeding to view the premises; and they thereupon caused a copy of said petition, and of order of notice thereon, to be served upon the Clerk of the Town of

CANTON, being the town within which such discontinuance was prayed for, fifteen days at least before the time appointed for said view: and also caused copies of an abstract of said petition and of said order of notice to be posted in two public places in said town: and to be published in the CANTON JOURNAL, a newspaper published in said County, said posting and publication having been seven days at least before the time appointed for said view, that all persons and corporations interested for or against said petition, might then and there appear and be heard if they saw fit.

And on the said ninth day of October, 1962, the Commissioners, Russell T. Bates, Clayton W. Nash and Everett M. Bowker, met at the time and place specified in said order, when and where the petitioners appeared and the Town of CANTON was represented by its Selectmen; and the said Commissioners then viewed the route and premises, and heard all persons and corporations interested; and no party interested objected: and thereupon the said Commissioners did adjudge that common convenience and necessity require that said way be discontinued as prayed for in said petition.

And thence the same was continued and adjourned from time to time to this meeting.

And now the said Commissioners, by courses and distances, metes and bounds do discontinue said Green and Green Lodge Streets between State Highway Route #128 and a line northerly and parallel 60.00 feet to the southerly line of Green Lodge Street.

And the line of said discontinuance of said Green and Green Lodge Streets is as follows:

The northerly line which is 60.00 feet northerly and parallel to the southerly line begins at a stone bound on the northerly line of Green Lodge Street, as laid out by the Norfolk County Commissioners by Return dated January 24, 1933; thence S-59-01-10-E a distance of 217.80 ft. to a stone bound; thence

by a curve to the right with a radius of 810.00 feet a distance of 265.60 feet to a stone bound; thence continuing on the same curve a distance of 265.60 ft. to a stone bound which is on the northerly line of Green Lodge Street as laid out by the Norfolk County Commissioners by Return dated January 24, 1933.

And the said County Commissioners determine that all lands north of said line laid out as said Green Lodge Street under Return dated January 24, 1933, which is shown as Parcel #2, be discontinued as a highway.

And it is further determined by the County Commissioners that that portion of Green Street between Parcel #2 and Route #128, which is shown as Parcel #1, be discontinued as a highway.

And it is further determined by the County Commissioners that an easement fifteen (15) feet in width shall be retained for the Town of Canton for water purposes as shown on the plan which is made a part of this Return.

Said line and discontinuance is shown upon a plan entitled "Plan showing the discontinuance as a highway of a portion of Green and Green Lodge Street, Canton between Route #128 and the northerly line of Green Lodge Street as shown as made by the Norfolk County Commissioners by Return dated November 13, 1962. Scale: 1 inch = 40 feet. Wallace S. Carson, County Engineer" and signed by "Russell T. Bates, Chairman," which plan is filed herewith and made a part of this Return.
