Administration Offices, 614 High Street, Dedham were appointed by the Commissioners as the time and place for commencing and proceeding to view the premises; and they thereupon caused a copy of said petition, and order of notice thereon, to be served upon the Clerk of the Town of NORWOOD, being the town within which such discontinuance was prayed for, fifteen days at least before the time appointed for said view: and also caused copies of an abstract of said petition and of said order of notice to be posted in two public places in said town: and to be published in the PATRIOT LEDGER, a newspaper published in Quincy, Mass., said postings and publication having been seven days at least before the time appointed for said view, that all persons and corporations interest ed for or against said petition, might then and there appear and be heard if they saw fit.

And on the said twenty-eighth day of November, 1990, the Commissioners, James J. Collins and Mary P. Collins, met at the time and place specified in said order. (David C. Ahearn being disqualified by reason of residence) when and where the petitioners appeared and the Town of NORWOOD was represented by its Selectmen; and the Commissioners then viewed the route and premises, and heard all persons and corporations interested; and no party interested objected: and thereupon the said Commissioners did adjudge that common convenience and necessity require that said way be discontinued as prayed for in said petition.

And thence the same was continued and adjourned from time to time to this meeting.

And now the Commissioners, James J. Collins, Mary P. Collins and Bruce D. Olsen, by courses and distances, metes and bounds, do nereby discontinue a portion of said UNIVERSITY AVENUE, as prayed for in said petition.

And the lines of said discontinuance of UNIVERSITY AVENUE are as follows: beginning at a stone bound on the southerly line of UNIVERSITY AVENUE as laid out by the Norfolk County Commissioners by Return dated June 6, 1984, said bound being opposite station 9+81.19 of said 1984 layout of UNIVERSITY AVENUE; thence southerly and southwesterly by a 970.00 ft. radius curve, 160.80 ft. to a stone bound; thence S 2°-53'-26" W, 155.44 ft. to a stone bound; thence to the left by a 1030.00 ft. radius curve 679.60 ft. to a stone bound; said bound being 60.00 ft. southwesterly of the last bound on the northerly line of said 1984 layout of UNIVERSITY AVENUE and opposite station 0+00.17; thence by the southerly line of UNIVERSITY AVENUE as laid out by the Town of Norwood October 27, 1966, N34°-54'-48"W, 129.88 ft. to a stone bound on said 1984 layout of UNIVERSITY AVENUE; thence to right by a 830.00 ft. radius curve 614.33 ft. to a stone bound; thence N7°-29'-40"E, 192.50 ft. to a stone bound; thence S82°-30'-20"E, 5.00 ft. to a stone bound; thence northerly and northwesterly by a 600.00 ft. radius curve, 77.44 ft. to the point of beginning. The last four lines being by said southerly line of said 1984 layout of UNIVERSITY AVENUE. Being shown as "Parcel 1- 7700± S.F." and "Parcel 2- 16,500± S.F." on a plan hereinafter referred to.

And it is determined by the Commissioners that all lands within the lines above described are hereby discontinued as a highway.

And the Commissioners do herewith retain, take and lay out an easement for the benefit of, and on behalf of, the Town of Norwood over the entire discontinued area above described, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining and repairing any and all present or future municipal utilities, including sewer, water, drains, electricity, telephone and all other types of utilities.

All of said lines and parcels are shown upon a plan. entitled "Plan showing the Discontinuance of a portion of UNIVERSITY AVENUE, Norwood, between Station 0+00.17 and Station 9+81.19 as made by the Norfolk County Commissioners by Return dated April 3, 1991, Scale: 1 inch= 40 feet. Alvah L. Downs, County Engineer and signed by James J. Collins, Chairman" which plan is filed herewith and made a part of this return.

And permanent stone bounds will be erected at the termini and angles of said discontinuance as indicated on said plan.
