RESPECTFULLY REPRESENT YOUR PETITIONERS, inhabitants of the Town of Bellingham in said County, that common convenience and necessity require that the way known as CENTRE STREET, a public way in said town, be relocated between Station 38+00 and Station 52+00 of the Norfolk County Commissioners layout of December 1, 1953 for the purpose of making alterations in the course or width of said way and discontinuing portions no longer required to maintain the way, including but not limited to that portion of land described as Center Street Island, Parcel, "Norfolk County" as per Plan attached hereto and made a part of this Petition.

WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONERS PRAY that said way may be relocated within the limits above specified.

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This petition was presented to the Commissioners and duly entered at a meeting of said Commissioners, held at Dedham, aforesaid, on the Fourth day of October, 1989, by adjournment of their September meeting next preceding: A notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law: and the first day of November, 1989, and two-thirty o'clock in the afternoon

at their Administrative Offices, 614 High Street in said Dedham were appointed by said Commissioners as the time and place for commencing and proceeding to view the premises: and they thereupon caused a copy of said petition and of order of notice thereon to be served upon the Clerk of the Town of BELLINGHAM, being the town within which such relocation of way was prayed for, fifteen days at least before the time appointed for said view, and also caused copies of an abstract of said petition and of said order of notice to be posted in two public places in said town: and to be published in the Milford Daily News, a newspaper published in Milford, said posting and publication having been seven days at least before the time appointed for said view, that all persons and corporations interested, for or against said petition, might then and there be heard if they saw fit.

And on the said first day of November, 1989, the Commissioners, David C. Ahearn, Mary P. Collins and Acting Commissioner Henry W. Ainslie, met at the time and place specified in said order, when and where the petitioners appeared, and the Town of BELLINGHAM was represented by its Selectmen; and the said Commissioners then viewed the route and premises, and heard all persons and corporations interested, and thence the same was continued and adjourned from time to time to a meeting of the Commissioners held at Dedham on the thirtieth day of May, 1990, a notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law, at which time the Commissioners, James J. Collins, David C. Ahearn and Mary P. Collins, appointed the eighteenth day of July, 1990 and two-thirty o'clock in the afternoon at their Administration Office, 614 High Street in said Dedham as the time and place for again commencing and proceeding to view the premises.

And having given notice of the time and place appointed and for the purpose aforesaid in the same manner as the notice and publication were given and made before first proceeding to view, the Commissioners met at the time and place appointed and then and there heard all persons and corporations interested and thereupon the Commissioners did adjudge that common

convenience and necessity require that said way be relocated as prayed for in said petition and appointed the twelfth day of September, 1990 and two-thirty o'clock in the afternoon at their Administration Offices, 614 High Street in said Dedham as the time and place when they would proceed to take such action in relation to said adjudication as by law they might be authorized to do so.

And having given notice of such adjudication and of the time and place appointed and for the purpose aforesaid in the same manner as the notice and publication were given and made before, the said Commissioners met at the time and place appointed and then and there heard all persons and corporations interested and said hearing was continued and adjourned from time to time to this meeting.

And now the Commissioners, James J. Collins, Mary P. Collins and Bruce D. Olsen, by courses and distances, metes and bounds, do relocate a portion of said CENTRE STREET as prayed for in said petition.

And the lines of relocation of CENTRE STREET are as follows:

The Westerly line begins at a stone bound on the westerly line of Centre Street as laid out by the Norfolk County Commissioners by return dated December 1, 1953, said bound being opposite Station 38+80.93 of said 1953 layout; thence N.18°-36'-20"W., 353.95 ft. by the westerly line of said 1953 layout to a stone bound; thence N.58°-51'-53"E., 41.09 ft. to a stone bound; thence southeasterly and easterly by a 25.00 ft. radius curve, 40.61 ft. to a stone bound; thence N.69°-44'40"E., 79.98 ft. to a stone bound; thence to the left by a 25.00 ft. radius curve, 27.49 ft. to a stone bound; thence N.06°-44'-40"E., 326.22 ft. to a stone bound; thence to the right by a 4060.00 ft. radius curve, 280.27 ft. to a stone bound; thence northerly and westerly by a 20.00 ft. radius curve, 56.40 ft. to a stone bound; thence N.60°-53'-00"W., 40.00 ft. to a point on said westerly line of said 1953 layout of Centre Street; thence N.29°-07'-00"E., 257.91 ft. by the westerly line of said 1953 layout to a stone bound opposite Station

51+39.99.

The Easterly line begins at a stone bound on the easterly line of Centre Street as laid out by the Norfolk County Commissioners by return dated December 1, 1953, said bound being opposite Station 39+29.98 of said 1953 layout and at the corner of Park Street; said bound also being N.57°-28'-42"E., 77.50 ft. from the first bound on the westerly line as above described; thence N.06°-44'-40"E., 668.72 ft. by the easterly line of said 1953 layout to a stone bound; thence to the right by a 4000.00 ft. radius curve, 358.18 ft. by the easterly line of said 1953 layout to a stone bound; thence N.11°-52'-30" E., 180.42 ft. by the easterly line of said 1953 layout to a point, said point being S.78°-07'-30" E., 60.00 ft. from the last bound on the westerly line above described.

And the said Commissioners do likewise hereby lay out as a separate way that portion of Centre Street between Stations 42+0 and 49+0 as formerly located but not included in the above described relocation and the lines of said way so laid out are as follows:

The westerly line begins at a stone bound which is on the westerly line of Centre Street as above described; thence northwesterly and northerly by a 400.00 ft. radius curve, 207.52 ft. to a stone bound; thence N.11°-07'-10"E., 152.91 ft. to a stone bound; thence to the right by a 600.00 ft. radius curve, 188.47 Ft. to a stone bound; thence N.29°-07'-00"E., 178.78 ft. to a point which is on the westerly line of Centre Street as above described. This Westerly line being a portion of the westerly line of Centre Street as laid out by the Norfolk County Commissioners by return dated December 1, 1953.

The easterly line begins at a stone bound which is on the westerly line of Centre Street as above described; said bound being N.58°-51'-33"E., 41.09 ft. from the first bound on the westerly line of the separate way as above described; thence northwesterly and northerly by a 360.00 ft. radius curve, 177.85 ft. to a stone bound; thence N.11°-07'-10"E., 152.91 ft. to a

stone bound; thence to the right by a 560.00 ft. radius curve, 175.90 ft. to a stone bound; thence N.29°-07'00"E., 178.78 ft. to a stone bound which is on the westerly side of Centre Street as above described; said bound being S.60°-53'-00"E., 40.00 ft. from the last bound on the westerly line of the separate way as above described.

The easterly line heretofore described is 40 .00 ft. easterly from and parallel to the westerly line.

And the Commissioners do hereby take for the purposes of a highway all the fee and rights incident to a public highway in the lands included within the lines of location hereinbefore described, all as shown upon a plan entitled "Plan Showing the Relocation of a Portion of Centre Street, Bellingham, between Station 38+80.93 and Station 51+39.99, as made by the Norfolk County Commissioners by return dated September 11, 1991. Scale: 1 inch = 60 feet. Alvah L. Downs, County Engineer" and signed by "James J. Collins, Chairman" which plan is filed herewith and made a part of this Return in accordance with the Provisions of Chapter 79 of the General Laws and all acts and amendments thereof and in addition thereto.

And permanent stone bounds will be erected at the termini and angles of said way relocated aforesaid.

And it is determined by the Commissioners that all portions of the existing highway lying outside the lines herein established are hereby abandoned and the title transferred as follows:

Parcel A Town of Bellingham 78,392 S.F.

And it is determined by the Commissioners that all the expense of making the relocation of way prescribed in this Return and Order, including the expense of maintaining said way, and all land and other damages and expenses incident thereto shall be paid out of the treasury of the Town of BELLINGHAM, and should the County be put to any legal expense or any other expense relating to damages, or any further damages be recovered, they shall be paid out of the treasury of said town.

And the Commissioners have heard the proprietors of lands and property, rights and interest, taken or affected by these proceedings, and have considered and estimated the damages done to the parties respectively, whether by taking their property or injuring it in any manner, and having allowed by way of set off, the benefits, if any to the property of said parties in the premises.
