Bench Mark:
A Mass. Geodetic T.B.M. No. 3171 on
the south side of Chestnut St., 17 feet from
the center line; 95 feet east of center
of Main St. (Route No. 140); 87 feet northwest
of the northwest corner of a house. A monel
rivet, set in the north end of a large
outcropping boulder. Elev. = 301.44

Bench Mark:
A U.S.C. & G.S. and State Survey bound
No. 11G on the N.Y., N.H. & H.R.R., 32 feet south-
east of the center of Chestnut St. and 24.2
feet southeast from pole No. 939 on south
side of street, west of track. Elev. = 289.40
