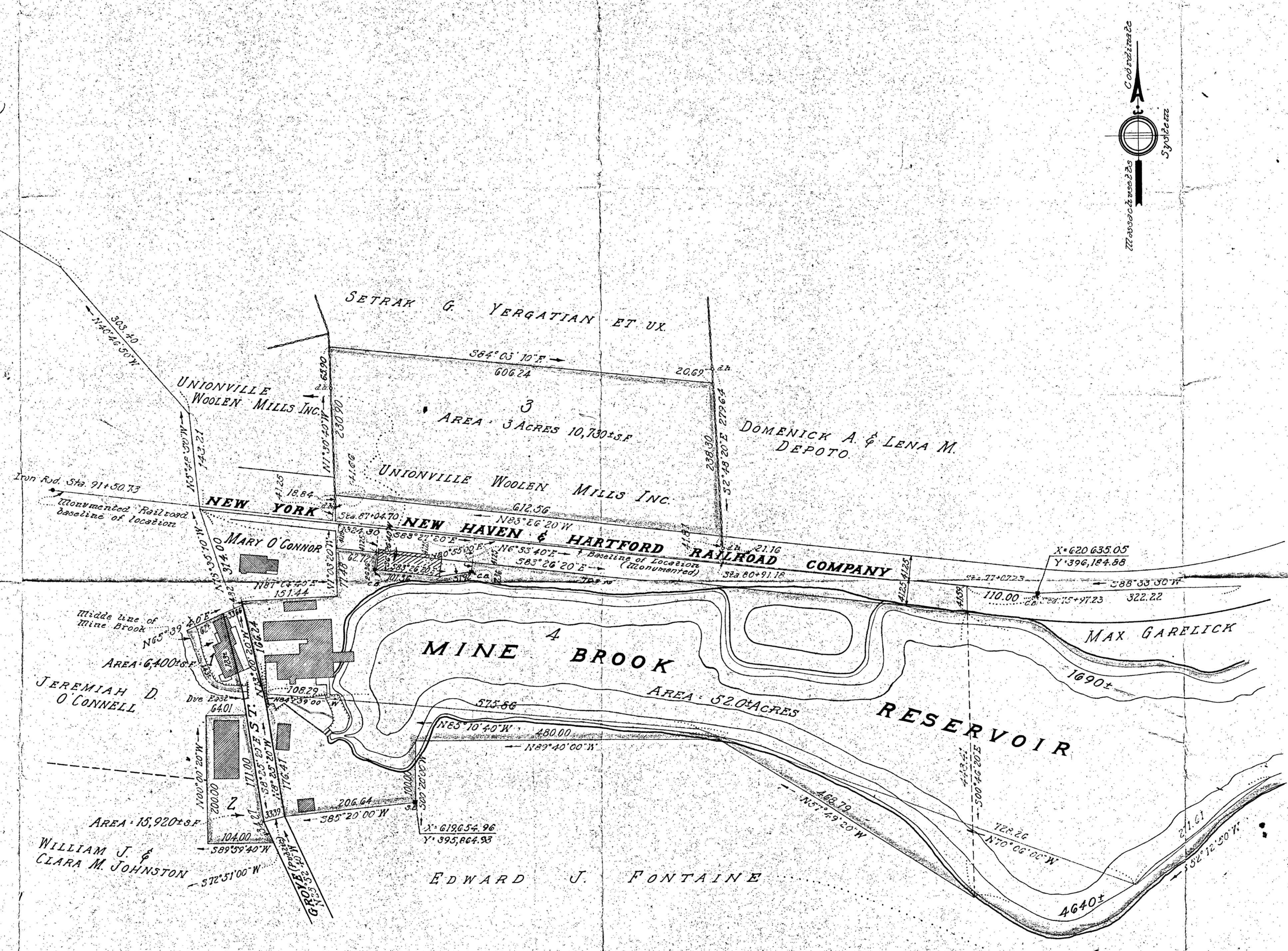
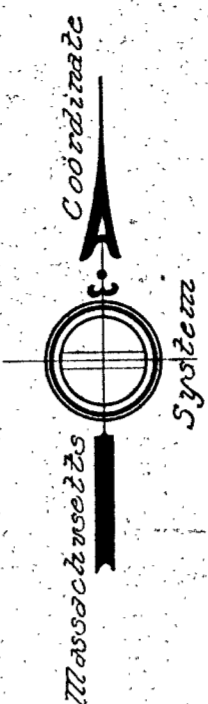


Note: Connection shown is a part of loop traverse to Station 17-DB and 17-DC shown on Sheet 2, Closure 1:24,000

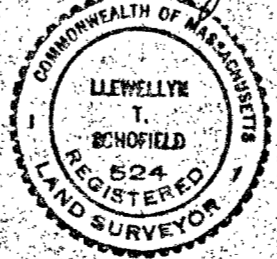

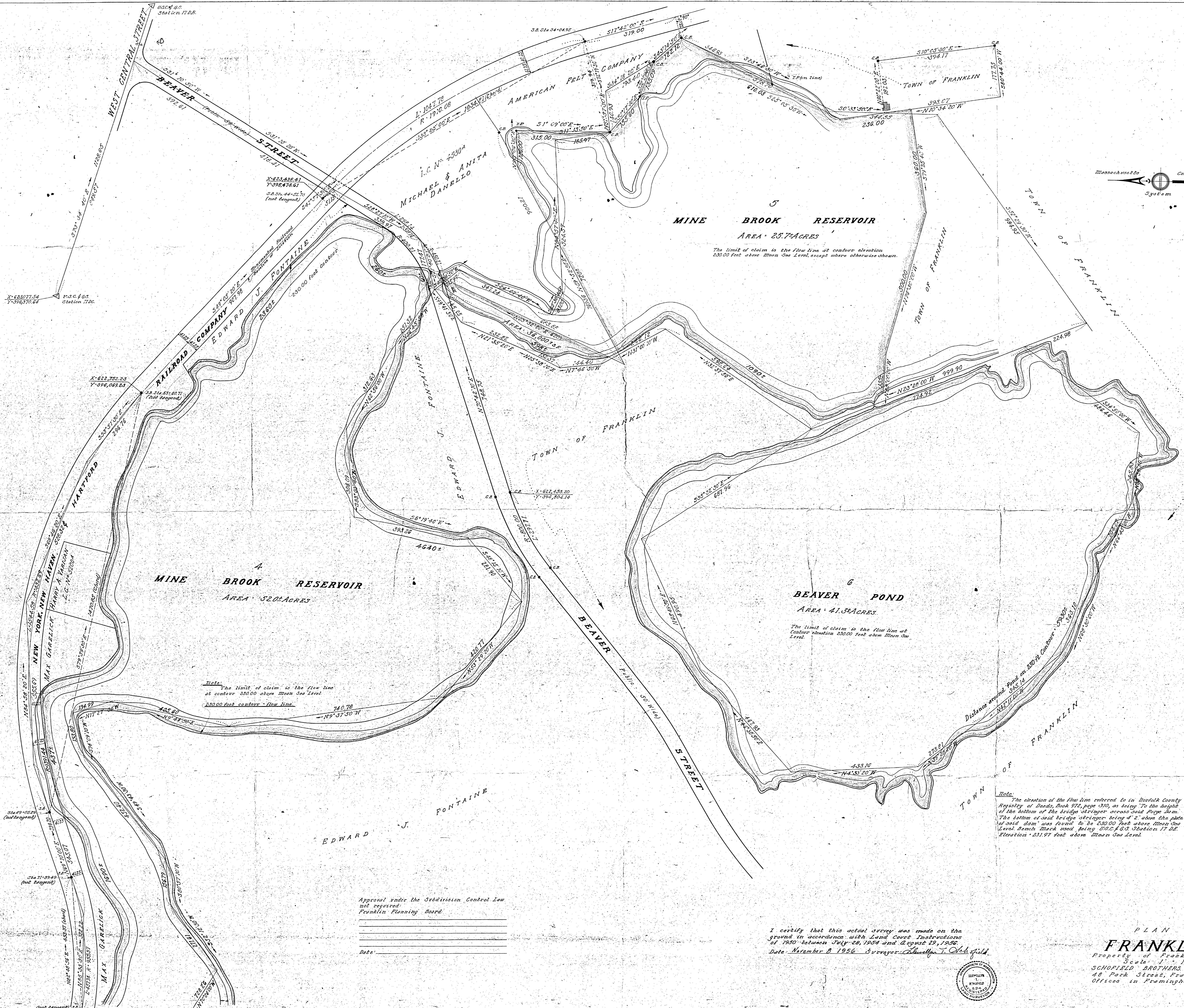
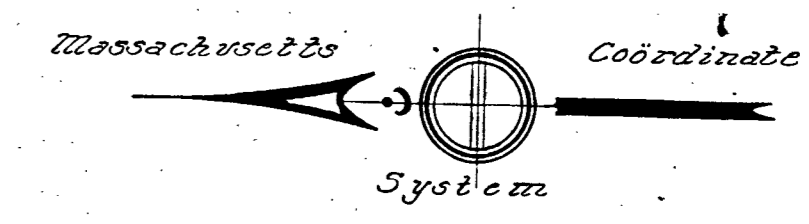

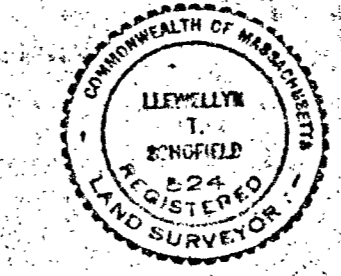
